Le Jardinnet is easily reachable from the ferry ports of Le Harve, Caen, Cherbourg and Dieppe and is a 3hr car journey from Calais.

It is possible to catch a train from Bernay or Lisieux into the centre of Paris. The journey only takes about an hour.
